



Creative Interclub Competition Rules for 2009-2010

This is the Second year that digital files will compete alongside 35mm slides in the same competition. The following text explains the rules of entry.

Rules:

- A club may enter six 2x2 color slides or 6 digital files in each competition; but not a combination of both. You may switch formats only in the next competition.
- Entries are not limited as to subject matter or treatment but they must be the work of a bona fide resident club member and must reach the designated judging place by the deadline. The slides must also be titled and must fit a standard 2x2 projector. No person may have more than two slides or two digital files entered in any one competition month, even though a member of more than one registered club. In the event of excessive entries by one person all but the two highest scoring slides or digital files entered by that person will be disqualified. Award of Merit and Honorable Mention slides or digital files may never again be entered and if re-entered will be disqualified. Identical or near-duplicate slides or digital files may not be entered in the same season. Disqualified slides or digital files will not receive points.
- Slides must be identified by title, maker's name and address, club name, corner spot for correct viewing, and must be numbered to correspond to the entry form.
- For Slides:
 - **The file name must contain the club reference, initials of the owner, numbered the same as the entry sheet and the title. For example if Tracey Thompson from the Cranbury Digital Camera Club entered an image titled "Koala" the file name would be: cdcc01.TT.Koala.jpg. Susan Cowles' entry titled "Dana In A Cloud" would be cdcc02.SC.Dana In A Cloud.jpg**
- Slides, must be accompanied by completed entry forms, adequate return postage, a return label and should be sent by first class mail. CD's will not be returned so therefore no return postage will be needed.
- Digital entries will be handled via a direct link online.
- You will not have to fill out an entry form as that is generated automatically → <http://www.psaexhibition.com/exh-model/cpid-creative-1.php>
- For naming of these files just follow the directions on the form.

- An email address for each maker will be needed.
- Please email me your contact information including your address and phone number.
- By submitting an image to the competition you agree to allow PSA/CPID to use them for promotional, handouts, viewing on a secure website when possible, the year end show and any other promotional need PSA/CPID may have.
- The Closing Date for all 3 competitions is the 1 of that month. The first month deadline has been extended to the 30th of November. The Judging club should judge the entries within 14 days of the competition deadline. If a club's entry arrives after the deadline the club will generally have the privilege of submitting a makeup entry in the next competition. The judging club may choose to judge entries that arrive after the deadline but before the Judging as long as they can do this without interfering with the Judging. This should always be done for foreign entries. Any domestic entry that is not judged should be returned to the submitting club. Any foreign entry that is not Judged should be sent to the Director for makeup entry in the next competition.
